## **Show Rules**

- The schooling show series will be governed by HCBC rules. It is the responsibility of the rider to have read and understood all the rules both HCBC and show rules. They will be strictly adhered to
- Mistreatment of any horse on the grounds, abusive or foul language, use of alcohol or drugs by contestants, parents, or guardians, shall be removed from the grounds, forfeiting their entry fees/prizes.
- Outside assistance or coaching from the sidelines, will cause elimination of the competitor being assisted while in competition. (The exception being the warm up classes)
- Rider may enter two consecutive divisions. Horses/ ponies cannot be compete in anymore than 2 divisions.
- No Refunds without a DR/VET certificate
- Stallions are not to be handled/shown by minors and unruly horses will be excused.
- Standard English attire & tack per HCBC is encouraged. Riding boots and helmet for juniors are mandatory.ASTM approved helmets mandatory for all riders jumping. Show Jackets are not required but riders must dress workmanlike in Hunter type attire (dark jackets etc..)
- Only 8 horses to gallop/canter/lope at once.
- Trot pole & X rail classes are for those just starting out with either green riders or green horses, it is a walk/trot class and no demerits for trotting on course.
- Disputes maybe taken to Show Manager before the show is over.
